

Bulletin 4 – 13 June 2023

Welcome to the fourth and final bulletin of the Monkey League 2022/23 season.

Winners and losers

Arsenal may have run out of steam in the Premier League title race, but the Gunners had just enough sting to keep London rivals Brentford away from top spot. The Bees buzzed off their last three opponents to notch up nine points to fly past Newcastle United in second place. Manchester City may have won the Premier League (at a canter in the end as Gary Neville predicted), but their zero handicap meant the Citizens finished as low down as ninth. An end of season rally from Liverpool ensured the Reds climbed up to fourth from bottom while Chelsea's costly season continued on and off the pitch and left the Blues at the foot of the table. Relegated sides Leicester City and Southampton completed the bottom three.

Burnley dismantled the rest of the Championship upon their return and became just the sixth club to accrue over 100 points. Fellow promoted teams Luton Town and Sheffield United were the Clarets' closest challengers but were still just as far away in the Monkey League Championship. Pre-season favourites Norwich did not have much to sing about as the Canaries finished the season with just one win in the last 11 games. Relegated Wigan Athletic and heavily fancied Watford made up the bottom three.

If there was an award for highest Monkey League scorers, Plymouth Argyle would win it. The League One side won their remaining six games to score over 100 points, but the Pilgrims were ploughed down by Tractor Boys Ipswich Town until the very end. A draw against Fleetwood Town cost Ipswich the opportunity to also become centurions, but a good harvest all things considered. Forest Green Rovers may run green but their results read red. Three losses to end the season confirmed their relegation to League Two and bottom spot in Monkey League One.

No change in Monkey League Two saw Stevenage hold off Leyton Orient thanks to three wins to finish the season. Carlisle United and Northampton Town are a bit further adrift, but it means that all four promoted sides finish in the top four of Monkey League Two. A strong finish kept Crawley Town in the football league, but it wasn't enough to elevate the Red Devils from last place. Rochdale and AFC Wimbledon joined Crawley Town in the bottom three.
