Welcome to the second bulletin of the 2023/24 Monkey League season.

Winners and losers

The end of Spurs' trophy drought may finally be upon us, with the North London side topping both the Premier League and the Monkey Premier League table on current standings. Strong starts for European contenders Aston Villa and Brighton continue as they find themselves in 2nd and 3rd place, with the remaining position in the top 4 being nailed down by the Hammers. In the words of the politest Sheffield Untied fan, the Blades see themselves 'hecking-bottom' of the table after eight games, and results such as an 0-8 home defeat won't go very far in moving them from last spot. The remaining relegation spots are occupied by a newly promoted Burnley side struggling to find their footing in the Premier League, being kept company down at the bottom by a Bournemouth side who are no doubt regretting the seemingly premature sacking of last season's managerial saviour Gary O'Neil.

Following promotion from League 1 last season, it comes as a bit of a surprise to see Ipswich Town harvesting wins in the Championship so far this season. 'The Tractor Boys' lead the Monkey League after a strong start to their domestic campaign. The zero handicap seems to be having little effect on Championship leaders Leicester, who after dropping points in just one game all season find themselves 2nd in the standings. Like their city counterpart, it's not been the best of starts for 'The Owls' Sheffield Wednesday 'Hoo' find themselves rock bottom of the table after failing to win any of their opening eleven games. The two Sheffield sides will need to find a bit of steel, else the city may be answering last season's double promotion with an immediate double relegation.

Despite having played one game fewer than the teams around them, Oxford United are still flying high at the top of the Monkey League 1 table, with actual league leaders Portsmouth docked just behind in 2nd. Reading find themselves as the worst performer across all four divisions, though understandable considering they've been deducted four points. Another side who started the wrong side of zero this year in Wigan are also struggling towards the bottom, while less than two points are separating a Cheltenham side who haven't been at the races so far this season from bottom spot.

Wimbledon sit top of the Monkey League 2 after serving out 3 wins on the spin prior to drawing their most recent game. MK Dons, who were top of the Monkey League at the time of the most recent bulletin, find themselves slipping down the table into 18th, while Stockport who were previously in 23rd spot are sitting comfortably in 6th. The bottom three spots are occupied by Tranmere, Sutton and Forest Green, all of whom are in the exact same positions in the League 2 table and will be hoping to pick up form so they're not omitted from the Monkey League next season.

Sharon Royston moves from 11th to claim the top spot this week, with previous leader Aaron Mooney finding himself in 2nd position heading into the international break. Things have somehow gotten worse for Monkey League organiser George Metcalf, who not only finds himself bottom of the standings again but is now being beaten by all 1,000 Monkeys.
